

FINJA SANDER

Finja Sander, born in 1996 in Hildesheim (Germany), lives and works in Berlin. She completed her Fine Arts studies at the Berlin University of the Arts in the classes of Ursula Neugebauer and Valérie Favre, graduating in 2022 as a Meisterschülerin. In 2023, she received the UdK Berlin Art Award. In 2025, she was awarded the Artheon Art Prize for her performative series Für Morgen. In 2026, she received the Art Prize of the City of Aschaffenburg.

“With machines and muscle power,” Sander investigates the social structures and historical sediments through which communities and collective identities are constituted. Central to her work are questions of verticality and horizontality—not only as physical arrangements, but as social and political principles. Rather than treating these models as fixed opposites, Sander explores their overlap and instability through photography, sculpture, and performance. Her works often respond to existing architectures and sites, treating them as active carriers of memory, power, and social relations.

Her research and performative engagements with forms of remembrance culture—from Ernst Barlach’s memorial *Der Schwebende* (1927) and the German mountain films of the 1920s and 1930s to contemporary references from popular culture—serve as an entry point into broader questions of collective imagination, historical continuity, and the organization of power.
